School opens for a soft start at 8:45am—9am. Please note there should be only one adult at drop off to help us minimise large crowds on the yard, social distancing must be maintained at all times. With this in mind, it is also extremely important that staff movement around school is kept to a minimum. This is to ensure year group bubbles are kept as safe as possible. We **MUST** ask that you bring your children to school on time and collect them on time from their allocated collection points.

Registers will be taken at 9am, any children arriving at school after this time must be brought to the main office and signed in by an adult. If your child is ill or absent for any reason, you **MUST** contact the school office every day they are absent by 9am with a reason for their absence.

Please do not collect your children early unless it is for a pre-agreed reason. Every time the office staff have to collect children, they are potentially being put at risk. In the same way every time a child is late and has to be taken to their bubble the risk increases.



STOP

At the end of the day we have had a lot of parents arriving early to collect children which results in lots of people on the playground. The gates will not open until 3:10pm. Please remember you can collect your children anytime between 3:15pm and 3:30pm.

Please can we ask you to park considerately outside of school and the surrounding areas. Please do not block residents driveways. Cars should not be parked on the white lines opposite school. Children are being reminded to take extra care when crossing the roads outside of school.



FACE MASK REQUIRED

Masks must be worn on the school premises at all times, this includes dropping children off at breakfast club, normal drop off/pick up times and at after school club pick up.



A polite reminder that there should be no chocolate bars or sweets in your child's packed lunch. They should follow healthy balanced guidelines containing a selection of food such as sandwiches, healthy crisp-like snacks, fruit, snack bars, yoghurts, biscuits, etc. Cakes/ cake bars are also allowed for a 'dessert'.
